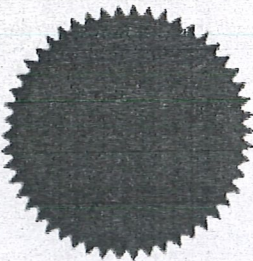

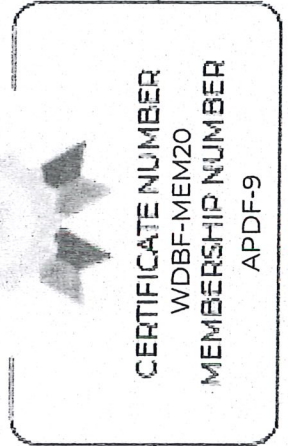

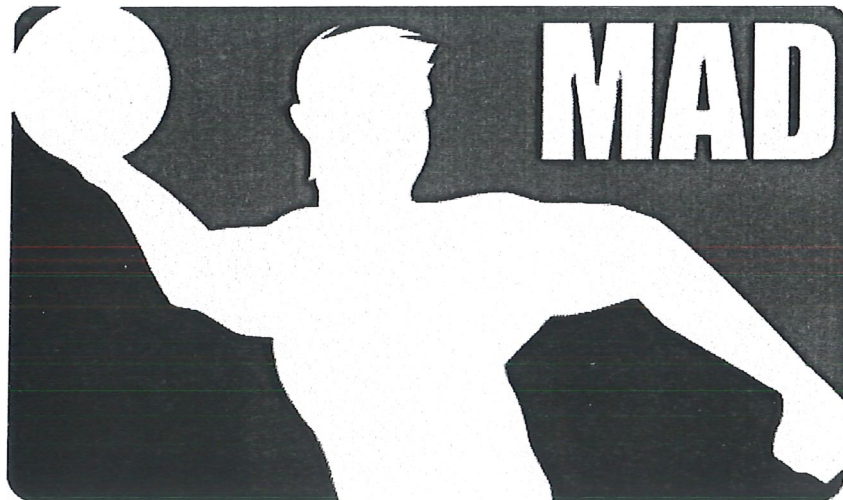

FASAL 1: NAMA

Badan Sukan ini dikenali dengan nama *MALAYSIAN ASSOCIATION OF DODGEBALL* atau *PERSATUAN DODGEBALL MALAYSIA* ringkasnya disebut sebagai *M.A.D* di dalam Perlembagaan ini.

FASAL 2: ALAMAT DAN TEMPAT URUSAN

2.1 Alamat Berdaftar

Alamat berdaftar & urusan *M.A.D* ialah di:-

***LOT 5, JALAN KIP 3, KAWASAN PERINDUSTRIAN KEPONG 52200 WPKL***

2.2 Alamat berdaftar dan alamat urusan ini tidak boleh diubah tanpa kelulusan Jawatankuasa Induk Persatuan dan hanya boleh dikuatkuasakan setelah mendapat kebenaran bertulis daripada Pesuruhjaya Sukan Malaysia.

FASAL 3: DEFINISI

3.1. **PERSATUAN** bermakna **Persatuan Dodgeball Malaysia**

- 3.2. **MESYUARAT AGUNG TAHUNAN (AGM)** bermakna mesyuarat yang **wajib** diadakan oleh Persatuan ini pada tiap-tiap tahun seperti yang disebutkan dalam fasal 13 perlembagaan ini.
- 3.3. **JAWATANKUASA INDUK (COUNCIL)** bermakna Jawatankuasa Induk bagi Persatuan seperti yang disebutkan dalam fasal 16 Perlembagaan ini.
- 3.4. **JAWATANKUASA (COMMITTEES)** bermakna Jawatankuasa yang sah dibentuk atau dilantik di bawah Perlembagaan ini mengikut Fasal 18.
- 3.5. **PEJABAT** bermakna alamat berdaftar Persatuan seperti yang ditetapkan dalam Fasal 2 Perlembagaan ini.
- 3.6. **AHLI PERSATUAN (MEMBERS)** bermakna ahli yang disebutkan dalam fasal 7 Perlembagaan ini.
- 3.7. **PESURUHJAYA** bermakna Pesuruhjaya Sukan yang dilantik di bawah Seksyen 10 Akta Pembangunan Sukan 1997.
- 3.8. **LEMBAGA EKSEKUTIF (EXECUTIVE BOARD)** bermakna ahli yang dilantik oleh Presiden untuk menguruskan hal ehwal harian Persatuan
- 3.9. **“LAND DODGEBALL”** bermakna permainan dodgeball di atas permukaan lantai
- 3.10. **“TRAMPOLINE DODGEBALL” (AIR DODGEBALL)** bermakna permainan dodgeball yang dimainkan diatas permukaan trampoline.
- 3.11. **“BEACH DODGEBALL” (DODGEBALL PANTAI)** bermakna permainan dodgeball di pantai atau berpasir.

- 3.12 **“DIGITAL DODGEBALL”** bermakna permainan dodgeball yang dimain secara digital, konsul, joystick, virtual reality, augmented reality dan lain-lain.
- 3.13 **“SUKAN PENYINGKIRAN”** Sukan Dodgeball adalah sukan penyingkiran dimana objek (tertakluk dengan keselamatan) seperti bola dibaling untuk menyingkirkan pihak lawan. Oleh itu, objek seperti bola mempunyai komposisi dan saiz tersendiri. Komposisi bola (atau objek) boleh diperbuat daripada getah, busa (foam), kain, bola yang mengembung (inflatables) dan tidak mengembung (non-inflatables) sebagai contoh.
- 3.14 **“DISCIPLINE” ATAU VARIATIF PERMAINAN”** Sukan Dodgeball sesuai dimainkan dipelbagai permukaan dan didefinasikan sebagai “Discipline” atau variatif permainan dodgeball seperti Dodgeball Trampolin (Trampoline Dodgeball), Dodgeball Pantai (Beach Dodgeball) dan Digital Dodgeball. Setiap variatif permainan Dodgeball mempunyai peraturannya masing-masing.

#### **FASAL 4: OBJEKTIF DAN MATLAMAT**

- 4.1. Untuk menggalakkan dan membangunkan sukan dodgeball di peringkat Kebangsaan.
- 4.2. Untuk mengekalkan hubungan baik dan kedudukan baik dengan semua badan pengelola dan pengawalseliaan Antarabangsa bagi sukan dodgeball.
- 4.3. Untuk memastikan prosedur pemilihan bagi ahli sukan, pegawai, jurulatih dan mana-mana orang lain untuk mewakili Negara dalam sukan dodgeball adalah terbuka dan adil.

- 4.4. Untuk mewakili Negara Malaysia dalam mana-mana pertandingan sukan dodgeball yang terdiri daripada pelbagai discipline/variation seperti "Land Dodgeball", "Beach Dodgeball", "Trampoline Dodgeball", Digital Dodgeball dan apa jua jenis sukan penyingkiran.
- 4.5. Untuk memastikan akaun teraudit sepenuhnya serta laporan tentang segala aktiviti, penggunaan dan perbelanjaan semua wangnya bagi tahun kewangan Persatuan yang sebelumnya, dikemukakan kepada Pesuruhjaya Sukan berserta dengan apa-apa laporan lain yang dikehendaki oleh Pesuruhjaya Sukan.
- 4.6. Untuk memastikan bahawa Perlembagaan dan kaedah-kaedah Persatuan dipatuhi dan diikuti oleh semua ahli.
- 4.7. Menjalankan sebarang kegiatan amal atau sebarang jenis perniagaan untuk tujuan menambah kewangan Persatuan, asalkan tidak bercanggah dengan undang-undang negara.
- 4.8. Semua wang keuntungan yang didapati oleh Persatuan daripada penyertaannya dalam mana-mana perniagaan atau pelaburan akan digunakan semata-mata untuk melanjutkan, memajukan dan menjalankan objektif dan matlamat Persatuan ini. Sungguhpun begitu, peruntukan ini tidak menghalang sebarang pembayaran yang dibuat dengan tujuan baik untuk membayar gaji atau perbelanjaan atau kedua-duanya kepada sebarang ahli atau pekerja Persatuan ini. Persatuan juga boleh menubuhkan Badan Perniagaan dan boleh memiliki harta benda dengan syarat keuntungan hendaklah dimasukkan dalam Tabung Kewangan Persatuan.
- 4.9. Untuk menjalankan aktiviti tanpa diskriminasi tentang jantina, ras, warna kulit, agama, asal-usul, bahasa, kecenderungan politik atau apa-apa pandangan lain yang dipegang oleh anggota.



## **FASAL 5: LOGO /LAMBANG**



Logo/lambang Persatuan ini adalah

Merupakan bayangan (silhouette) atlet dodgeball di belakan warna merah dan biru sebagai warna laterbelakang dan tertutup dengan dengan corak persegi panjang (rectangular shape) Huruf M.A.D sebagai akronim Persatuan diposisikan di sudut kanan.

## **FASAL 6: KEAHLIAN (MEMBERSHIP)**

Keahlian Persatuan ini terbuka kepada warganegara Malaysia dan terbahagi kepada empat (4) kategori seperti berikut:

### **6.1. AHLI GABUNGAN (AFFILIATE MEMBER)**

Terdiri dari Persatuan sukan dodgeball di peringkat negeri, yang sah berdaftar di Pejabat Pesuruhjaya Sukan dan boleh mengundi serta diundi.

### **6.2. AHLI BERSEKUTU (ASSOCIATE MEMBER)**

Terdiri daripada badan dan majlis sukan yang menganjurkan program di peringkat kebangsaan dan antarabangsa, tetapi tidak mempunyai hak mengundi dan diundi.

**6.3. AHLI INDIVIDU (INDIVIDUAL MEMBER)**

Terdiri daripada ahli-ahli individu yang tidak melebihi lima (5) orang yang dilantik oleh Jawatankuasa Induk Persatuan dan boleh mengundi dan diundi.

**6.4. AHLI KEHORMAT (HONORARY MEMBER)**

Individu-individu yang pernah berjasa kepada Persatuan atau individu-individu yang boleh memberi sumbangan kepada Persatuan yang dilantik oleh Jawatankuasa Induk Persatuan.

**FASAL 7: YURAN KEAHLIAN**

7.1 Setiap ahli baru hendaklah membayar yuran pendaftaran dan tahunan kepada Persatuan seperti berikut :-

1	Ahli Gabungan	tiada	RM 990.00
2	Ahli Bersekutu	RM 250	RM 200
3	Ahli Individu	RM 100	RM 50
3	Ahli Kehormat	tiada	RM 50

7.2 Yuran tahunan hendaklah dibayar tidak lewat dari 1 Februari tiap-tiap tahun kepada Bendahari. Sekiranya yuran itu tidak dibayar, ahli yang berkenaan tidak boleh menghadiri Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan dan tidak boleh mengundi dan diundi.

7.3 Sekiranya yuran tahunan tidak dijelaskan dalam tempoh satu (1) tahun tanpa alasan yang munasabah, Jawatankuasa Persatuan berhak membatalkan keahlian ahli yang berkenaan.

- 7.4 Sekiranya ahli yang telah dibatalkan keahliannya ingin menjadi ahli semula, beliau dikehendaki untuk mengemukakan permohonan baru dengan menyertakan bayaran yuran pendaftaran, yuran tahunan dan penalti sebanyak RM100. Permohonan ini tertakluk kepada kelulusan Jawatankuasa Induk.

## **FASAL 8: PERMOHONAN MENJADI AHLI**

Semua permohonan menjadi ahli hendaklah dibuat secara bertulis dengan mengisi borang dan dikemukakan kepada Setiausaha. Jawatankuasa Induk boleh meluluskan atau menolak sebarang permohonan tanpa member alasan.

## **FASAL 9: KEISTIMEWAAN DAN HAK AHLI**

- 9.1. Tiap-tiap ahli Persatuan dibenarkan menyertai dalam segala kegiatan yang dianjurkan oleh Persatuan ini.
- 9.2. Setiap ahli Persatuan berhak menerima dengan percuma satu salinan Perlembagaan Persatuan sekali sahaja semasa pendaftaran.

## **FASAL 10: HAK MENGUNDI DALAM MESYUARAT AGUNG**

### **10.1 Ahli Gabungan**

Semua ahli gabungan yang membayar yuran sebelum 1 Februari adalah berhak untuk menghadiri Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan dan berhak menghantar **1** orang wakil ke Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan dan juga boleh mengundi dan diundi dalam mesyuarat tersebut.

### **10.2 Ahli Bersekutu**

Ahli bersekutu tidak berhak mengundi dan diundi tetapi boleh menghantar **2** orang wakil bagi menghadiri Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan sebagai pemerhati.



10.3 Nama-nama wakil ahli gabungan yang dipilih bagi menghadiri Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan hendaklah disampaikan secara bertulis kepada Setiausaha sekurang-kurangnya tujuh (7) hari sebelum Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan diadakan.

## **FASAL 11: PEMBERHENTIAN DAN PEMECATAN AHLI**

- 11.1 Mana-mana ahli Persatuan yang membuat permohonan bertulis untuk berhenti menjadi ahli dan permohonannya itu diluluskan oleh Jawatankuasa Induk Persatuan adalah dianggap sebagai telah berhenti menjadi ahli Persatuan.
- 11.2 Setiap ahli Persatuan yang didapati menjalankan sesuatu kegiatan yang bertentangan dengan Perlembagaan Persatuan bolehlah dipecat atau digantung keahliannya bagi sesuatu tempoh sebagaimana yang difikirkan munasabah oleh Jawatankuasa Tatatertib. Sebelum tindakan sedemikian ahli itu hendaklah diberikan surat tunjuk sebab. Pemecatan atau penggantungan itu hendaklah berkuatkuasa dari tarikh yang ditetapkan oleh Jawatankuasa Tatatertib. Ahli yang berkenaan boleh mengemukakan rayuan kepada Jawatankuasa Induk dalam tempoh masa empat belas (14) hari dari tarikh keputusan Jawatankuasa Tatatertib. Jawatankuasa Induk mempunyai kuasa sama ada untuk menerima, menolak atau membuat apa-apa keputusan yang lain berhubung dengan rayuan tersebut dan keputusan Jawatankuasa Induk adalah muktamad.

## **FASAL 12: MESYUARAT AGUNG**

- 12.1 Mesyuarat Agung adalah badan yang tertinggi dan menyeluruh bagi Persatuan ini berdasarkan kepada objektif dan matlamatnya.

- 12.2 Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan hendaklah diadakan tidak lewat dari tarikh 30 Jun tiap-tiap tahun pada tarikh dan tempat yang akan ditetapkan oleh Jawatankuasa Induk. Sekurang-kurangnya dua puluh satu (21) hari notis hendaklah diberikan secara bertulis oleh Setiausaha kepada semua ahli Persatuan. Notis itu hendaklah disertakan dengan agenda mesyuarat bersama-sama dengan semua salinan dokumen yang dinyatakan dalam agenda tersebut.
- 12.3 Kuorum Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan hendaklah dihadiri oleh tidak kurang dari satu pertiga ( $1/3$ ) daripada bilangan keahlian yang layak mengundi. Sekiranya korum tidak mencukupi selepas satu (1) jam dari masa yang ditetapkan, maka Mesyuarat itu hendaklah ditunda kepada tarikh baru dalam tempoh tiga puluh (30) hari. Sekiranya korum masih tidak mencukupi pada tarikh baru mesyuarat itu, maka ahli-ahli yang hadir bolehlah meneruskan mesyuarat tetapi **tidak berkuasa untuk meminda perlembagaan**.
- 12.4 Setiausaha hendaklah menghantar kepada semua ahli dan Pesuruhjaya Sukan salinan Penyata Tahunan Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan dalam tempoh tiga puluh (30) hari setelah selesai mesyuarat itu.

### FASAL 13. TUGAS MESYUARAT AGUNG

Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan mestilah mengandungi antara lain agenda-agenda berikut :-

- i. menerima dan mengesahkan minit Mesyuarat Agung yang lepas;
- ii. Menerima dan meluluskan Laporan Jawatankuasa berkenaan kegiatan Persatuan dalam sepanjang tahun yang lalu;



- iii. Menerima dan meluluskan laporan Bendahari dan Penyata Kewangan yang telah diaudit bagi tahun yang lalu ;
- iv. Menguruskan hal-hal lain yang dibentangkan di dalam Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan ; dan,
- v. Memilih Jawatankuasa Induk yang baru mengikut fasal 15.1 Perlembagaan ini dan melantik dua (2) orang juruaudit mengikut fasal 21.1 Perlembagaan ini setiap dua (2) tahun sekali.

## **FASAL 14. MESYUARAT AGUNG KHAS**

- 14.1 Mesyuarat Agung Khas bagi Persatuan ini boleh diadakan:
- i. bila difikirkan mustahak oleh Jawatankuasa atau dengan kehendak Presiden.
  - ii. atas permintaan beramai-ramai dengan bertulis oleh tidak kurang daripada separuh (1/2) daripada jumlah ahli yang berhak mengundi dengan menerangkan tujuan-tujuan dan sebab-sebabnya.
- 14.2 Mesyuarat Agung Khas yang diminta oleh ahli-ahli hendaklah diadakan pada satu tarikh dalam tempoh satu (1) bulan dari tarikh penerimaan permintaan mesyuarat.
- 14.3 Pengumuman dan agenda untuk Mesyuarat Agung Khas itu hendaklah diedarkan kepada semua ahli-ahli oleh Setiausaha sekurang-kurangnya dua puluh satu (21) hari sebelum tarikh yang ditetapkan untuk bermesyuarat.
- 14.4 Korum Mesyuarat Agung boleh digunakan untuk Mesyuarat Agung Khas tetapi dengan syarat jika kuorum tidak mencukupi selepas setengah (1/2) jam dari waktu yang telah ditetapkan bagi mesyuarat itu maka mesyuarat itu hendaklah dibatalkan, dan sekurang-kurangnya enam (6) bulan daripada tarikh ini, Mesyuarat Agung Khas atas permintaan ahli-ahli dengan tujuan yang sama tidak boleh diadakan.

14.5. Tidak boleh diadakan pemilihan semasa Mesyuarat Agung Khas diadakan.

## **FASAL 15: JAWATANKUASA INDUK**

15.1 Jawatankuasa Induk Persatuan hendaklah terdiri daripada :-

- i. seorang (1) Presiden ;
- ii. seorang (1) Timbalan Presiden;
- iii. tiga (3) orang Naib Presiden ; dan
- iv. lapan (8) orang Ahli Jawatankuasa .

15.2 Setiausaha, Penolong Setiausaha, dan Bendahari dan seorang (1) wakil setiap negeri adalah dilantik oleh Presiden dengan persetujuan Jawatankuasa Induk dalam Mesyuarat pertama Jawatankuasa Induk selepas Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan tetapi kesemua mereka tidak mempunyai hak mengundi dan diundi.

15.3 Pemegang-pemegang jawatan dalam Jawatankuasa Induk dan dalam Jawatankuasa-Jawatankuasa yang lain hendaklah :-

- i berumur lapan belas (18) tahun ke atas;
- ii bukan seorang yang muflis;
- iii tidak pernah dikenakan tindakan disiplin oleh mana-mana badan sukan dalam tempoh lima (5) tahun yang lalu;
- iv tidak disabitkan kesalahan jenayah dalam tempoh lima (5) tahun yang lalu; dan
- v. sempurna akal.

15.4 Sekiranya terdapat kekosongan jawatan disebabkan penjawat Jawatan telah melepaskan jawatan ataupun telah meninggal dunia, maka calon yang mendapat undi kedua terbanyak di dalam Mesyuarat Pemilihan yang terlepas adalah dengan tersendiri layak untuk memegang jawatan tersebut serta dipersetujui oleh Persatuan. Jika calon yang demikian tidak ada ataupun menolak tawaran jawatan itu, maka pemilihan bagi mengisi kekosongan tersebut perlu dibawa ke dalam mesyuarat yang akan datang.



## **FASAL 16: TUGAS-TUGAS JAWATANKUASA INDUK**

- 16.1. Melantik Pengerusi Jawatankuasa-Jawatankuasa.
- 16.2. Menguatkuasakan dasar-dasar dan keputusan Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan atau khas.
- 16.3. Mengurus dan mentadbir Persatuan dan menjalankan program-program Persatuan.
- 16.4. Mengkaji dan meluluskan perbelanjaan pentadbiran dan program-program yang diluluskan.
- 16.5. Meluluskan peraturan-peraturan baru atau yang dipinda untuk di bahas dalam Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan atau khas.
- 16.6. Menimbang rayuan keputusan Jawatankuasa Tatatertib bagi ahli-ahli Persatuan.
- 16.7. Membuat lantikan dan pemecatan kakitangan pengurusan yang bergaji.
- 16.8. Menimbang permohonan menjadi ahli Persatuan.

## **FASAL 17: JAWATANKUASA-JAWATANKUASA**

- 17.1. Lembaga Eksekutif (Executive Board)
- 17.2. Jawatankuasa Kewangan (Finance)
- 17.3. Jawatankuasa Pertandingan (Competition)
- 17.4. Jawatankuasa Teknikal (Technical)
- 17.5. Jawatankuasa Pasukan Kebangsaan (National Team)
- 17.6. Jawatankuasa Pembangunan (Development)
- 17.7. Jawatankuasa Tatatertib (Governance)
- 17.8. Jawatankuasa Komunikasi & Media (Communications & Media)
- 17.9. Jawatankuasa Pemasaran & Penajaan (Marketing & Sponsorships)
- 17.10. Jawatankuasa Pembangunan Kelab & Athlete (Club & Athlete Development)



## **FASAL 18: TUGAS AHLI JAWATANKUASA INDUK**

- 18.1. **Presiden** : dalam masa jawatannya hendaklah menjadi Pengerusi dalam semua mesyuarat Jawatankuasa Induk dan bertanggungjawab atas kesempurnaan perjalanan semua mesyuarat serta disiplin ahli-ahlinya
- 18.2 **Timbalan Presiden** hendaklah membantu Presiden melaksanakan tanggungjawab menguruskan pentadbiran Persatuan. Dia hendaklah memangku dan melaksanakan tanggungjawab Presiden selama ketiadaan Presiden
- 18.3 **Naib Presiden** hendaklah membantu Presiden dan Timbalan Presiden dalam menguruskan pentadbiran Persatuan. Semasa ketiadaan Presiden dan Timbalan Presiden, Naib Presiden yang kanan hendaklah memangku jawatan tersebut.
- 18.4 **Setiausaha** bertanggungjawab dalam segala pengurusan dan pentadbiran Persatuan mengikut Perlembagaan dan menjalankan arahan-arahan Mesyuarat Agung atau Jawatankuasa Induk. Beliau bertanggungjawab mengenai surat-menyurat, menyimpan semua buku-buku, surat-surat dan kertas-kertas kecuali buku kira-kira dan buku kewangan. Dia hendaklah hadir dalam semua mesyuarat dan membuat catatan-catatan mesyuarat. Setiausaha hendaklah di dalam tempoh tiga puluh (30) hari selepas tarikh Mesyuarat Agung menghantar penyata-penyata tahunan serta dokumen-dokumen yang perlu kepada Pesuruhjaya Sukan Malaysia sebagaimana yang dikehendaki di bawah Akta Pembangunan Sukan 1997.
- 18.5 **Bendahari** hendaklah membuat kutipan yuran keahlian dan menyimpan kira-kira berkenaan semua perkara kewangan dan bertanggungjawab di atas ketepatannya.



18.6 **Ahli Jawatankuasa** hendaklah menguruskan Jawatankuasa-jawatankuasa yang ditubuhkan di bawah fasal 17 dan menjalankan tugas seperti yang diarahkan oleh Presiden

18.6.1 **Tugas Pengerusi Jawatankuasa-Jawatankuasa** adalah seperti yang berikut:-

- a) **Lembaga Eksekutif (Executive Board)** : Menjalankan pengendalian operasi Persatuan harian serta membantu dan menyemak kerja-kerja Jawatankuasa.
- b) **Jawatankuasa Kewangan (Finance)** : Pengerusi Jawatankuasa ini hendaklah menguruskan semua mesyuarat Jawatankuasa dan melantik Ahli Jawatankuasa nya. Tugas utama Jawatankuasa ini ialah mencari sumber pendapatan Persatuan seperti tajaan, bantuan dari kerajaan, derma atau caracara lain yang sah dari segi undang-undang Persatuan dan undang-undang negara.
- c) **Jawatankuasa Pertandingan (Competition)** : Pengerusi Jawatankuasa ini hendaklah menguruskan semua mesyuarat Jawatankuasa dan melantik Ahli Jawatankuasanya. Tugas utama Jawatankuasa ini ialah mengelolakan pertandingan-pertandingan diperingkat Kebangsaan.
- d) **Jawatankuasa Teknikal (Technical)** : Pengerusi Jawatankuasa ini hendaklah menguruskan semua mesyuarat Jawatankuasa dan melantik Ahli Jawatankuasanya. Tugas utama Jawatankuasa ini ialah melibatkan hal-ehwal kepegawaian teknikal sukan ini.
- e) **Jawatankuasa Pasukan Kebangsaan (National Team)**: Pengerusi Jawatankuasa ini hendaklah menguruskan semua mesyuarat Jawatankuasa dan melantik Ahli Jawatankuasanya. Tugas utama

Jawatankuasa ini ialah membawa pasukan dodgeball Malaysia ke pertandingan antarabangsa.

- f) **Jawatankuasa Pembangunan (Development)** Tugas Pengerusi Jawatankuasa ini adalah menjalankan program pembangunan sukan dodgeball dari peringkat akar – umbi terutamanya di peringkat sekolah, IPT dan komuniti.
- g) **Jawatankuasa Tatatertib (Governance)** : Tugas utama Jawatankuasa ini ialah untuk memutuskan kes-kes berhubung salah laku ahli dan menjatuhkan hukuman terhadap ahli berkenaan.
- h) **Jawatankuasa Komunikasi & Media (Communications & Media):** Tugas utama Jawatankuasa ini ialah untuk mempromosikan Persatuan melalui aktiviti persidangan akbar dan “social media”
- i) **Jawatankuasa Pemasaran & Penajaan (Marketing & Sponsorships):** Tugas utama Jawatankuasa ini mencari penaja dan memasarkan program dodgeball untuk Persatuan.
- j) **Jawatankuasa Pembangunan Kelab & Atlet (Club & Athlete Development)** : Tugas utama Jawatankuasa ini ialah untuk membangunkan kelab dodgeball diperingkat negeri dan membangunkan atlet dodgeball.

## FASAL 19. MESYUARAT JAWATANKUASA INDUK

- 19.1 Jawatankuasa Induk hendaklah bermesyuarat sekurang-kurangnya sekali di dalam masa **TIGA (3)** bulan. Notis bagi tiap-tiap mesyuarat hendaklah diberikan kepada ahli-ahli tujuh (7) hari terlebih dahulu. Presiden dengan bersendirian atau tidak kurang daripada empat (4)



orang Jawatankuasa bersama-sama boleh memanggil supaya diadakan Mesyuarat Jawatankuasa Induk pada bila-bila masa.

- 19.2 Sekurang-kurangnya lima (5) daripada bilangan Ahli Jawatankuasa Induk hendaklah hadir bagi mengesahkan perjalanan dan mencukupkan korum mesyuarat.

## **FASAL 20: KEWANGAN**

20.1 Kewangan Persatuan boleh diperolehi melalui :-

- i. yuran tahunan dan penalti kemasukan semula;
- ii. derma dan tajaan;
- iii. Bantuan dari kerajaan atau badan-badan berkanun ;
- iv. hasil-hasil perniagaan Persatuan; dan
- v. sumber-sumber lain yang dibenarkan oleh undang-undang negara.

20.2. Pendapatan Persatuan yang diperolehi hendaklah digunakan bagi tujuan mencapai objektif dan matlamat Persatuan dan ahli-ahlinya seperti yang disebut dalam Perlembagaan ini.

20.3. Semua cek Kelab hendaklah ditandatangani oleh Bendahari dan Presiden atau Setiausaha .

20.4. Perbelanjaan yang lebih daripada **RM51,000** bagi sesuatu masa tidak boleh dibayar tanpa kelulusan terlebih dahulu oleh Jawatankuasa Induk.

20.5. Perbelanjaan kurang daripada **RM50,000** bagi sesuatu masa boleh dibayar tanpa kelulusan terlebih dahulu oleh Jawatankuasa Induk.



- 20.6. Bendahari boleh menyimpan wang runcit tidak lebih daripada **RM4,999** dalam sesuatu masa. Wang yang lebih daripada jumlah itu mesti dimasukkan ke dalam akaun Persatuan.
- 20.7. Penyata dari hal wang diterima dan dibelanjakan berserta Lembaran Imbangan bagi setahun hendaklah disediakan oleh Bendahari dan diperiksa oleh Juruaudit mengikut Perlembagaan dengan seberapa segera setelah tamat tahun kewangan. Penyata kira-kira yang diaudit hendaklah dikemukakan untuk kelulusan Mesyuarat Agung yang berikutnya dan salinan-salinannya hendaklah diedarkan untuk makluman ahli-ahli Persatuan.
- 20.8. Tahun kewangan Persatuan ini ialah dari 1 Januari hingga 31 Disember pada tiap-tiap tahun.

## **FASAL 21: JURUAUDIT**

- 21.1 Orang yang bukannya Ahli Jawatankuasa boleh dilantik semasa Mesyuarat Agung sebagai Juruaudit. Mereka akan memegang jawatan selama dua (2) tahun dan boleh dilantik semula. Tugas Juruaudit ialah membuat pemeriksaan terhadap penyata kewangan Persatuan dan membuat laporan dan pengesahan penyata-penyata yang berkaitan dengan kewangan.
- 21.2 Mesyuarat Agung boleh juga melantik Firma Audit yang bertauliah bagi menjalankan kerja-kerja auditan Persatuan sekiranya perlu.

## **FASAL 22: TAFSIRAN UNDANG-UNDANG**

Di antara Mesyuarat Agung, Jawatankuasa Induk boleh memberikan tafsirannya kepada perlembagaan ini. Jawatankuasa Induk boleh memutuskan perkara-perkara yang tidak terkandung di dalam perlembagaan ini sekiranya mustahak.



## **FASAL 23: PERTIKAIAN DALAMAN**

Adalah menjadi tugas Jawatankuasa Tatatertib dengan kerjasama Jawatankuasa Induk Persatuan untuk menyelesaikan apa-apa pertikaian yang timbul di kalangan anggotanya, mengikut prosedur dalaman ditetapkan selaras dengan Akta Pembangunan Sukan 1997.

## **FASAL 24: PENAUNG/PENASIHAT**

- 24.1. Jawatankuasa Induk Persatuan boleh juga melantik orang-orang yang layak menjadi penaung atau penasihat bagi Persatuan ini, sekiranya perlu.
- 24.2. Penaung atau Penasihat mempunyai kuasa untuk mengundi dan membuat keputusan bagi pihak Persatuan.

## **FASAL 25. PINDAAN PERLEMBAGAAN**

- 25.1 Perlembagaan ini tidak boleh diubah atau dipinda kecuali dengan keputusan Mesyuarat Agung.
- 25.2 Permohonan untuk perubahan-perubahan atau pindaan kepada Perlembagaan hendaklah dibuat kepada Pesuruhjaya Sukan Malaysia dalam masa tiga puluh (30) hari dari tarikh keputusan mesyuarat yang memutuskan perihal perubahan atau pindaan tersebut. Perubahan atau pindaan kepada Perlembagaan ini tidak boleh dikuatkuasakan selagi tidak mendapat kelulusan Pesuruhjaya Sukan Malaysia.



## FASAL 26: LARANGAN

- 26.1 Segala bentuk perjudian dan aktiviti-aktiviti yang bertentangan dengan undang-undang Malaysia adalah dilarang dilakukan dalam mana-mana premis Persatuan.
- 26.2 Persatuan tidak boleh mencuba menghalang atau dengan apa cara juga mengganggu perniagaan atau mengambil peranan di dalam gerakan kesatuan sekerja seperti yang diterangkan ke dalam Ordinan Kesatuan Sekerja 1959.
- 26.3 Persatuan ini tidak boleh menjalankan loteri sama ada dikhaskan kepada ahli-ahli Persatuan atau tidak, atas nama Persatuan atau pemegang-pemegang jawatan tanpa kelulusan daripada Mesyuarat Agung Tahunan dan pihak berkuasa.
- 26.4 Persatuan tidak boleh terlibat dalam mana-mana kegiatan politik atau parti politik, atau bergabung atau mengadakan hubungan dengan apa jua parti politik dan menggunakan nama Persatuan dalam apa jua isu-isu politik.

## FASAL 27: PEMBUBARAN

- 27.1 Persatuan ini boleh dibubarkan dalam Mesyuarat Agung yang khusus untuk tujuan ini dan dengan keputusan oleh dua pertiga (2/3) daripada ahli Persatuan.
- 27.2 Sekiranya Persatuan ini hendak dibubarkan secara yang disebut di atas, maka segala hutang dan tanggungan Persatuan yang sah mengikut undang-undang hendaklah dijelaskan dan baki wang atau harta benda (aset) yang tinggal hendaklah diserahkan kepada **Pemegang Amanah Rayat Malaysia**.

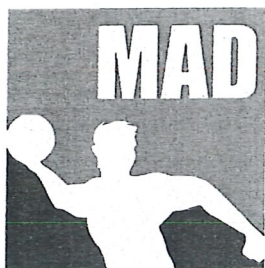

Dato' Radha expressed his sporting experience and how he was involved with various sports association such as Malaysian Hockey Confederation (MHC), Malaysian Aesthetic Group Gymnastics Association (MAGGA), lawn bowl and archery among others. He is determined to reposition Dodgeball as a high performance sport.

The Acting-President introduced Louis Santhana as the Executive Secretary of Malaysia Association of Dodgeball whom Dato' Radha had brought him to serve its daily operation tasks and is funded by Dato' Radha himself.

Dato Radha commented on the challenges faced by MAD during his first (5) five months as the Acting-President and the mechanism to find solution as follows:-

a) Re-strengthening the relationship between Kementerian Belia & Sukan (KBS) and MAD. It started with a press conference with Deputy Sports Minister, YB Steven Sim at the 2018 Team Malaysia Recognition Awards. Dato Radha has also obtain exclusive rights for MAD Dodgeball to be a competed sport in the Malaysia Sports Challenge 2019 (previously known as Hari Sukan Negara) by KBS in October this year.

b) To strengthen the policies and regulation of MAD, Dato Radha engaged a legal sport advisor to consult the Council Members on a fair, open and transparent governance approach, which resulted in today's transparent and open AGM.

c) An Executive Secretary was brought into the Council to assist with day to day operations, Mr. Louis Santhana is responsible to carry out the duties of behalf of the MAD Council and today's AGM is a result from Mr. Louis.

d) To promote team-work and understanding with MAD Council Members, Dato Radha sponsored 2019 Buka Puasa Dinner at the Raintree Club where 20 members attended.

e) Dato Radha spoke about productivity and efficiency as a high performance sport association and to ensure the success of Dodgeball where he offered MAD a new operating office and including warehousing in Kepong. Dato Radha has been actively working on Dodgeball development with the Council within the last few months.

f) Dato Radha emphasized the importance of CSR Partner for MAD Dodgeball that could assist in national dodgeball development. He introduced TNB as a potential CSR Partner to MAD and the council has meet with TNB representative

and pending for next proposal from the Council. The general secretary Wai Tat is working on this.

g) Sharing is caring said Dato Radha and requested all State Affiliates to share their challenges faced within and external to MAD Council Members. He said there are solutions and methods to approach every situation. He praised Sabah (pro-temp) Dodgeball Association for seeking support from MAD in which Dato Radha was able to connect them to higher authority to expedite their formation of state association.

h) MAD Dodgeball must be competed at national multi-sport event in which Dato Radha had open doors for Dodgeball to be competed at SUKMA. Dato Radha announced that a verbal agreement was made to have MAD Dodgeball competed as a Demo Sport in SUKMA Johor 2020.

i) Dato Radha also reported on his visit Kementerian Pendidikan Tinggi (KPT)'s Bahagian Sukan and to ensure that MAD Dodgeball will be a competed sport in UPSI SUKIPT 2020.

j) Dato Radha announced that MAD and Asia Pacific Dodgeball Federation will host Asia Pacific Dodgeball Invitational & Elite category in April 2020. He also said that the Ministry of Tourism Malaysia has verbally approved to endorse this regional dodgeball tournament.

k) Dato Radha pointed to strengthen MAD Finances by developing self-sustaining programs and embark on entrepreneur skills to plan and customize a sustainable program that is achievable at State and National level. He jokingly said, failing which, the President shall take responsibility such as himself where he was asked to volunteer to sponsor (i) Team Malaysia training venue and (ii) 2019 AGM.

**MOTION 2 : PROPOSAL FOR THE REVISE EVENT SANCTION PROCEDURES**

*This motion was brought into the attention due to latest announcement by Pesuruhjaya Sukan Malaysia (PJS) regarding Akta 576 regarding Event Sanction Regulations imposed officially last year 2018.*

- 1.1 The current event sanction requirement was to pay a minimal sanction fees of RM300 for Members and RM500 for non-members.
- 1.2 Additional charges for Technical Crew required (i.e. Technical Director, Marshals, Scorer & Timekeeper) as required by applicants.
- 1.3 There was no clear procedures of NGB's event sanction ruling to all State Associations and Members and shall be rectified immediately to follow suit Akta 576.
- 2.4 Therefore the proposed event sanction procedures are as follows:-

- a) Redefining NGB's event sanction as "organized dodgeball activity involving the NGB's community (database) and when any type of fee is charged for the participants.
- b) Any event applicants throughout Malaysia shall be approved only by the NGB and shall be co-responsible for the event's welfare.
- c) Applicants shall apply through respective State Associations' General Secretary, the General Secretary shall submit event information to the NGB's Hon. General Secretary for approval.
- d) The event shall be executed by the State Associations' and is the State Associations' responsibility to the event is conducted smoothly maintaining good relation with all involved.
- e) The proposed event sanction fees for applicants is RM300 for Members and RM500 for Non-Members (event organizers).
- f) The NGB has the right not to sanction an event due to reasons pertaining clashes

of event schedule, court or game requirements were not met, in-violation of constitution and other NGB's ruling as example.

g) Upon the agreement to sanction the event, the applicant shall receive an official letter from the NGB and applicants shall abide by NGB's Event Sanction ruling.

h) The proposed event sanction fee is divided between NGB and the State Association where for Members Sanction Events is RM100 to NGB and RM200 to State Association. While RM200 to NGB and RM300 to State Association for Non-Members Sanction Events.

i) The Hon Secretary shall be responsible to develop and publish NGB's Event Sanction Ruling and its procedures.

j) It is the NGB's responsibility to submit event reports to PJS after the event is completed; the State Association shall submit event reports to the NGB's Hon. General Secretary.

k) Attached is the latest information on Akta 576 for all members to read and understand the latest Sports Ruling by Pesuruhjaya Sukan Malaysia.

The proposed motion will effect MAD By-Law and a revision to include MAD Sanction policies in the By-Law.

The motion to revise MAD sanction policies which was proposed to passed by En. Salam (Selangor) and was seconded by En Andy (Melaka)

Motion to pass Motion 2 was unanimous.

6.3

**MOTION 3 : PROPOSAL FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ATHLETE'S FEES**

*The implementation to secure fees from Athletes is to assist the development of the sport that is being run as non-profits.*

3.1 Definition of Athletes' Fees is as "an individual participating in any NGB's events and programs as a member of any registered dodgeball clubs in Malaysia"

3.2 Unsanctioned Player is classified as "individuals' name not in NGB and State Association's record.

3.3 The NGB shall improve on Athlete's welfare such as insurance coverage as the next step and to be reviewed by November 2019.

3.4 The Athlete's Fees shall be paid by the club by 30<sup>th</sup> November annually along with the Annual Club Fees to the respective State Associations.

3.5 The State Association and the NGB shall keep all Athlete's record as Athlete's database and database records to be submitted to the NGB by 30<sup>th</sup> November annually.

3.6 The proposed Athlete's Fees is as follows:-

- (a) Schools – RM40 per year
- (b) Higher Education – RM50 per year
- (c) Community Clubs – RM60 per year

3.7 The Athlete's Fees goes directly into State Association's membership funds and to be used for sports development purposes.

3.8 The school Athlete's fees shall commence after dodgeball is in MSSM.

3.9 The Club Development Committee shall outline a clear procedure and SOP into the NGB's Bylaw and other related regulations.

There were few questioned raised over this topic however the answer is clear to be in favour of such fees towards the sport development.

The proposed motion will effect MAD By-Law and a revision to include Athlete's Fees in the By-Law.

The motion to include Athlete's Fees & policies which was proposed to passed by En. Mizan (Terengganu) and was seconded by Mr. Adam (Penang)

Motion to pass Motion 3 was unanimous.

#### 6.4 **MOTION 4 : REDEFINING NGB'S MEMBERSHIP STATUS**

*The purpose of redefining the NGB's membership status is to synergized its development towards high performance differentiating between the roles played by each members.*

4.1 The current NGB's membership is as follows:-

i) Affiliated Members (Ahli Bersekutu) – no voting rights and cannot be voted. These members were dodgeball clubs formed during 2009 to date who was registered as member to NGB. This changes dodgeball clubs to be registered at respective state and the clubs shall be managed under the state's supervision

ii) Associated Members (Ahli Bergabung) – With voting rights and can be voted. These members were the protemp committee to the NGB since 2009 to date. Moving forward the NGB shall associate itself with Associated Members only and no longer with Associated Dodgeball Clubs whom should had be formed as State Association by now.

4.2 The proposed changes for NGB's membership is as follows:-

i) Affiliated Members (Ahli Bersekutu) – Is now open to groups or organization that is working to develop the sport with NGB, they will be invited for NGB's AGM as observers and have no voting rights and cannot be voted. Example of

members are *MSN, ISN, KPT's Bahagian Sukan, Majlis Sukan IPT (Masiswa, Masum), KPM's Bahagian Sukan (MSSM)*

ii) Associated Members (Ahli Bergabung) – Is now open to only dodgeball State Association. Each State Association have 1 vote and is represented by State Association's Delegate as a Council Member to the NGB. They can be voted as Office Bearers.

iii) Similarly this membership process shall be executed by the State Associations, where 3 to 5 clubs (in the same state) are required to be formed as Ahli Gabungan to State Association.

iv) The revision of membership fees is as follows

a) Associated Members : Annual Membership fees RM990.

b) Affiliated Members : Annual Membership fees RM200 and RM250 as registration fees.

iv) Individual Members : Registration fees RM100 and annual fees of RM50

The proposed motion will effect MAD Constitution as follows:-

a) To redefine MAD Membership as per Article 6 (Keahlian)

b) To revise MAD Membership fees as per Article 7 (Yuran)

c) To redefine privileges and benefits as MAD Member as per Article 9 (Keistimewaan dan Hak Ahli)

d) To redefine MAD Voting right at Annual General Meeting as per Article 10 (Hak Mengundi Dalam Mesyurat Agung)

The motion to redefine MAD's membership which was proposed to passed by Pn.Kidayah (NS) and was seconded by En. Choong Jin Hoe (Perak)

Motion to pass Motion 4 was unanimous.

6.5 **MOTION 5 : CHANGE IN NGB'S OFFICE ADDRESS**

The house owner of the NGB's office will be selling the house and therefore will require a new office address

I) The current NGB's address is NO:26, Jalan Siput, Taman Billion, Cheras 56000. WPKL and to be change to Lot 5, Jalan KIP 3, Kawasan Perindustrian Kepong 52200 WPKL

The proposed motion will affect the change in MAD constitution as per Article 2 (Alamat dan Tempat Urusan)

The motion to change NGB's office was proposed to passed by Mr Andy (Melaka) and seconded by Pn Norizma (Putrajaya)

Motion to pass Motion 5 was unanimous.

6.6 **MOTION 6 : EXTENDING DODGEBALL DISCIPLINES & VARIATIONS**

The purpose of identifying and extending all types of "Dodgeball" that is played to be recognized as variant of Dodgeball to the NGB. The NGB defines the sport as "*a game of elimination, using various safe objects to eliminate opponent that is played on any surface deemed safe*"

The identified variants are

- a) Land Dodgeball : The general variant that was introduced since 2009
- b) Digital Dodgeball : A variant that is played as e-sport
- c) Beach Dodgeball : A variant that is played on beach
- d) Trampoline Dodgeball : A variant that is played on trampoline
- e) Traditional Dodgeball (variant) : Traditional versions of dodgeball before the sport was unified, example of *bola beracun, chopping, bola bayang and other types*

The motion will affect MAD Constitution as per Article 3 (Definasi) by adding the said variations/disciplines as above.

The motion shall include a new Article to be included as Nature of the Sport (Sifat Sukan Dodgeball) to assist the definition of the sport.

Dodgeball is redefined as

“The sport of Dodgeball is a sport of elimination where objects (subjective to safety) like balls are launched at opponents to eliminate them from a game. Therefore, such objects as balls of varying composition and size can be used (subject to approval on safety). Composition of balls (and or objects) can be foam, rubber, fabric, inflatables, non-inflatables, mixture of rubber and foam and so forth.

Dodgeball can be played in various surfaces and be defined as dodgeball discipline and/or variant namely Digital Dodgeball, Trampoline (Air) Dodgeball, Beach Dodgeball and including various traditional variation & discipline such as “Bola Beracun” or Poison Ball, Chopping or “Bola Chop”, “Bola Hamtam” and so forth

Such discipline will have its own game rules and regulation to cater to its unique surface and discipline”

The motion to extend Dodgeball discipline and variations was proposed to passed by Mr. Andy (Melaka) proposed and was seconded by En. Zuwairi (Putrajaya)

Motion to pass Motion 6 was unanimous.

#### 6.7 **MOTION 7 : CHANGE OF ASSOCIATION NAME**

To change the present status Association Name from Malaysia Association Of Dodgeball (MAD) to Malaysia Dodgeball Confederation (MDC), as it has high recognition to the Dodgeball Industry in Malaysia.

The motion to change the Association name will affect MAD Constitution particularly on (a) Article 1 (Nama) and (b) Article 5 Logo (Lambang)

The members agreed to pass this motion which was proposed by Dato Karthik (Selangor) and was seconded by En.Teo (WPKL)

The motion to change association's name was proposed to passed by Dato Karthik (Selangor) and was seconded by En.Teo (WPKL)

Motion to pass Motion 7 was unanimous.

6.8 **MOTION 8: OCM AFFILIATION APPLICATION**

MAD to apply to Olympic Council of Malaysia (OCM) for affiliation membership.

The motion was proposed by En.Zamri (Putrajaya) and seconded by Mr.Teo (WPKL) and was passed unanimously.

7 **MAD GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE TERM 2019-21**

In accordance to MAD Constitution, election shall be held once every 2 years, the 2019 General Election shall cast one vote from Each State Affiliates & one vote from each Individual Member of MAD.

In this 2019 AGM, there shall be 10 votes from 10 State Affiliates and everyone in the meeting, including the observers can be nominated into the MAD Executive Council Members for the term 2019 – 2021.

7.1 *PRESIDENT*

There were no contestants for the President's position which all members voted for Dato Radha as the President for 2019 – 2021

Dato' Radhakrishnan was declared the President without contest.

7.2 *DEPUTY PRESIDENT*

Nomination; Ms Ramona

There were no contestants for the Deputy President's position which all members proposed and voted for Ramona Yuen as the Deputy President for 2019 – 2021

Ramona Yuen retained her position as Deputy President without contest.

7.3 The (3) three VICE PRESIDENT(s)

A total of 8 (eight) Nominations was addressed from the floor which were En. Arahman (NS), Pn. Norizma (Putrajaya), Cikgu Gopal (MAD Member), Mohd Lufti (Selangor), Choong Jin Hoe (Perak), En. Yuzamri (Putrajaya), Dato Karthik (Selangor) & Mr. Alson Tay (Penang)

The members voted for the following :-

In his closing remarks, Dato Radha said, "I intend to strengthen MAD's governance on long term planning especially towards grassroots development and establish a proper pathway for MAD, Affiliates, Clubs and the National Dodgeball programs towards acknowledging talent and potential for skilled representation on a local and global stage."

He thanked everyone for supporting him as the President and congratulated the newly elected Council Members.

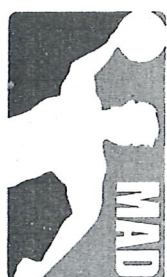

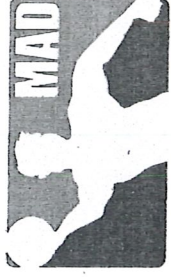

## **Malaysia Dodgeball Code of Ethics & Conduct**

This Code of Ethics and Conduct applies to all those involved in the sport of dodgeball under the jurisdiction of Malaysia Association of Dodgeball. All such individuals have a responsibility to act according to the highest standards of integrity, and to ensure that the reputation of dodgeball is beyond reproach.

Malaysia Association of Dodgeball is committed to maintaining the highest possible standards of behavior and conduct at dodgeball events. The following principle must be adhered to at all times so that dodgeball can be enjoyed by all and is divided into the following sections:

1. Coaches
2. Player Poaching
3. Players
4. Officials
5. Club Officials
6. Parents/family
7. Spectators
8. Young people
9. National Team and Performance Centre Staff
10. Anti Doping
11. Possible Sanctions

### **GENERAL PRINCIPLES**

All those involved in dodgeball must treat everyone equally and sensitively regardless of age, disability, gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural or social background, sexual orientation, religious belief, political affiliation or any other personal characteristic /feature.

Dodgeball Malaysia is opposed to any form of violent, offensive or discriminatory behavior and will act as necessary to remove individuals from dodgeball who do not abide by this Code of Ethics and Conduct.

Everyone involved in dodgeball, both adults and young people, have a responsibility to treat everyone with dignity, respect, sensitivity and fairness. In particular, be aware of the special needs of young people and vulnerable adults, and recognize that some face additional barriers.

Every young person or vulnerable adult involved in the game of dodgeball should be able to participate in an enjoyable and safe environment and be protected from abuse.

- 1.10. Ensure they hold Dodgeball Malaysia recognized qualifications and declare any affiliation, sponsorship or accreditation in a truthful and accurate manner.
- 1.11. Be receptive to employing systems of evaluation that include self-evaluation and also external evaluation in an effort to assess the effectiveness of your work.
- 1.12. Abide by all rules and policies of Malaysia Association of Dodgeball.
- 1.13. Promote prevention and education regarding the misuse of performance enhancing drugs and illegal substances.
- 1.14. Whilst working under the jurisdiction of Malaysia Association of Dodgeball will only coach individuals that are registered/affiliated to Malaysia Association of Dodgeball.
- 1.15. Not attempt to exert undue influences and pressures in order to obtain personal benefit or reward.
- 1.16. Must be able to recognise and accept when to refer or recommend players to other coaches or structures.
- 1.17. Agree what information will be treated confidentially (this does not preclude disclosure of information to persons who can be judged to have a right to know such as in matters of discipline, legal and medical requirements or where an individual's health, safety or wellbeing may be at risk);
- 1.18. Communicate and co-ordinate with medical practitioners in the diagnosis, treatment and management of players' medical /psychological problems.
- 1.19. Be a positive role model;
- 1.20. Project a good personal appearance of cleanliness and never smoke in the coaching environment, or coach whilst under the influence of alcohol or any other intoxicating substance.
- 1.21. Never use foul, sexist or racist language or act in a violent/abusive manner.
- 1.22. Refrain from undue public criticism of other coaches or match officials.

## **2. APPROACHING PLAYERS ALREADY REGISTERED WITH ANOTHER CLUB/ACADEMY/INSTITUTION**

*'Player poaching' is a serious offence.* It is poor practice to make direct contact with any player currently registered with another club/academy/institution with a view to them joining your club/academy/institution or to play for you in another tournament/competition, including representative teams.

Dodgeball Malaysia is keen to safeguard the welfare of young players and to respect their individual rights and any contact from a third party should be made in the first instance via the player's current club/academy/institution prior to contacting the players' parents/guardians. Any contact should be for legitimate dodgeball reasons only. Equally, it is essential that anyone holding personal information about young players respects the confidentiality of such information and does not disclose this without the proper authority.

## **3. PLAYERS : ALL AFFILIATED PLAYERS AGREE TO:**

- 3.1 Treat everyone equally and sensitively regardless of age, disability, gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religious beliefs or political affiliation.
- 3.2 Treat your team-mates and opponents, coaches, club officials and match officials with respect and consideration at all times – treat them as you would like to be treated.
- 3.3 Not use foul, sexist, racist language or offensive gestures at any time.
- 3.4 Know and abide by the rules and spirit of the game.
- 3.5 Avoid violence and rough play and help injured opponents.
- 3.6 Accept the decisions of the match officials without question or complaint (let your captain or coach ask the necessary questions) and avoid words or actions which may mislead a Match Official;
- 3.7 Abide by the instructions of the coach and club officials, provided they do not contradict the spirit of this Code of Ethics and Conduct or the rules of dodgeball.
- 3.8 Not attempt to improve individual performance with the use of banned substances/techniques.
- 3.9 Condemn the use of recreation and performance enhancing drugs and abide by all anti-doping requirements.

- 3.10 Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance through the whole game, even if it is considered already over.
- 3.11 Learn to accept victory and defeat with humility and dignity and without excessive emotional displays;
- 3.12 Work equally hard for yourself and your team – your team's performance will benefit and so will your own;
- 3.13 Be a good sport, applaud all good performance, whether by your team or by the opponent;
- 3.14 At the end of play applaud and thank your opponents and the match officials.

#### **4. MATCH OFFICIALS : ALL AFFILIATED MATCH OFFICIALS MUST:**

- 4.1 Treat everyone equally and sensitively, regardless of their disability, gender, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religion, age or political affiliation.
- 4.2 Not tolerate foul, sexist or racist language.
- 4.3 Only officiate in games or competition where all individuals are registered/affiliated to Malaysia Association of Dodgeball.
- 4.4 Realize that Malaysia Association of Dodgeball does not advise that officials travel alone with anyone under 18 years of age or a vulnerable adult to or from games. We advise you to always have another adult with you.
- 4.5 Be honest, consistent, objective, impartial and courteous when applying the rules of the game. Officials must resist any possible influence from protests on the part of participants or spectators of the game.
- 4.6 Claim any affiliation, sponsorship or accreditation in a truthful and accurate manner.
- 4.7 Show patience and understanding towards players who may be learning the game.
- 4.8 Make every effort to prepare fully for a match, both physically and mentally. On a physical level, be able to keep up with the speed of the game, and be alert and close enough to make correct decisions.

- 4.9 Decline to be appointed to a match if not completely physically or mentally fit to participate in that match (because of illness, injury, or for family or other reasons);
- 4.10 Refrain from requesting hospitality, or accept any hospitality offered and considered to be excessive.
- 4.11 Have regard to protecting the players by enforcing the laws of the game.
- 4.12 Show due respect when speaking with participants in the game, even in the event of infringements;
- 4.13 In reports, set out the true facts.
- 4.14 Refrain from publicly expressing any criticism of fellow officials.
- 4.15 Assist with the development of those with less experience.

**5. CLUB OFFICIALS : ALL CLUB OFFICIALS AGREE TO:**

- 5.1 Treat everyone equally and sensitively regardless of age, disability, gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religious belief or political affiliation.
- 5.2 Not use foul, sexist or racist language;
- 5.3 Use your official position to take action against any club member or spectator who harasses, abuses or uses foul, sexist or racist language.
- 5.4 Accept the responsibilities of the role that you have to set a good example of behaviour and conduct at all times and promote ethical principles;
- 5.5 Ensure your club is aware of and follows best practice guidelines to safeguard young people and vulnerable adults.
- 5.6 Ensure that proper supervision is provided by suitably qualified coaches and officials who are capable of promoting good sporting behaviour and good technical skills.
- 5.7 Ensure all equipment and facilities meet safety standards;
- 5.8 Resist all illegal or unsporting influences, including banned substances and techniques.

- 5.9 Encourage all players and coaches to abide by the rules and spirit of the game and do not manipulate the rules in order to benefit yourself personally or your club.
- 5.10 Show respect to match officials, coaches, players and others involved in the game.
- 5.11 Do not endeavour to influence the result of a game by any actions that are not strictly within the rules.
- 5.12 Remember sport is enjoyed for its own sake – play down the importance of awards.
- 5.13 Always have regard to the best interests of dodgeball, including where publicly expressing an opinion of the game others involved and any particular aspect of it.
- 5.14 Avoid words or actions, which may mislead a Match Official and accept their decisions.

**5. PARENTS GUARDIANS (AND OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS) : ALL FAMILY/GUARDIANS OF PARTICIPANTS WILL**

- 6.1 Teach your child to treat everyone equally and sensitively regardless of their age, disability, gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religious beliefs or political affiliation; gender, ethnic origin or cultural background.
- 6.2 Support all efforts to remove verbal, physical and racist abuse from dodgeball.
- 6.3 Not force an unwilling participant to take part in dodgeball.
- 6.4 Remember that young people are involved for their enjoyment – not yours;
- 6.5 Encourage all to play by the rules and respect the match officials;
- 6.6 Never ridicule or shout at a participant for making a mistake or losing a game;
- 6.7 Teach that effort and teamwork are as important as victory, so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment;
- 6.8 Remember that young people and vulnerable adults learn best by example;

6.9 Refrain from publicly questioning the judgment or honesty of match officials;

6.10 Recognize the value and importance.

**6. SPECTATORS : ALL SPECTATORS OF GAMES UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF MALAYSIA ASSOCIATION OF DODGEBALL WILL:**

7.1 Do not use offensive, discriminatory or obscene language or gestures. Do not harass or verbally abuse players, coaches, match officials or fellow spectators in any form.

7.2 Treat everyone equally and sensitively regardless of age, disability, gender, race, ethnic origin, cultural background, sexual orientation, religious beliefs or political affiliation;

7.3 Condemn the use of violence in all forms and refrain from any violent or aggressive behaviour;

7.4 Show respect for opponents and match officials. Without them there would be no game;

7.5 Acknowledge good performance and fair play by opponents as well as by your own team;

7.6 Remember the players are taking part for their enjoyment not yours;

7.8 Do not ridicule players who make mistakes;

7.9 Do not over emphasise the importance of winning;

7.10 On no account should you enter the court unless authorised otherwise.

**8. YOUNG PEOPLE**

There are additional requirements for how young people should be treated by adults and how young people should treat their peers.

**8.1 ADULTS TO YOUNG PEOPLE**

8.1.1 Be aware of how your language and behaviour may have an effect and ensure you do not use foul language, humiliate or bully any young person;

8.1.2 Make sure you are fully aware of and follow the latest guidance on working with young people.

8.1.3 Treat everyone with respect and dignity, recognising the additional needs or disadvantages of those with disabilities or from minority backgrounds;

8.1.4 Set a good example as young people will learn from you;

8.1.5 Make sure disciplinary actions are non violent/humiliating and use rewards, praise and acknowledgment to reinforce good behaviour;

8.1.6 Listen and act if a young person tells you they're being bullied or abused.

## **8.2 YOUNG PEOPLE TO EACH OTHER SHOULD:**

8.2.1 Never bully, spread rumours or tell lies about other young people;

8.2.2 Welcome and include new players whatever their background or ability;

8.2.3 Control your emotions – verbal or physical abuse is not acceptable at any time;

8.2.4 Don't show off or try to humiliate other players;

8.2.5 Don't ridicule or blame team mates who make mistakes;

8.2.6 Make sure you tell your coach/parents if another young person confides in you and you think they need help.

## **9. NATIONAL TEAM AND PERFORMANCE CENTRE STAFF IN ADDITION TO THE COACH'S SECTION, NATIONAL AND PERFORMANCE CENTRE STAFF MUST:**

9.1 Ensure that the pathway remains open to newly identified players;

9.2 Never use their position to attempt to recruit players to any dodgeball club. 'Player poaching' is a serious offence.

9.3 Act as an ambassador and behave in a professional manner while representing Malaysia Association of Dodgeball.

9.4 Maintain a satisfactory criminal record disclosure and undertake additional training as deemed necessary by Malaysia Association of Dodgeball.

## **10. ANTI DOPING**

Malaysia Association of Dodgeball condemns and is totally opposed to performance enhancing and recreation drug use in the sport of dodgeball.

### **10.1 ALL INVOLVED IN DODGEBALL MUST:**

- 10.1.1 Familiarize themselves with the Malaysian Anti Doping Rules (refer at Olympic Council Malaysia)
- 10.1.2 Take sole responsibility for all foods, medications and supplements taken;
- 10.1.3 Be aware of the implications and penalties in place for a positive doping test result.
- 10.1.4 Be aware disciplinary action may be taken for criminal conviction for possession or use of drugs.

## **11. POSSIBLE SANCTIONS**

In affiliating to Malaysia Association of Dodgeball, everyone agrees to abide by this Code of Ethics and Conduct and all of Malaysia Association's policies and procedures.

- 11.1 Malaysia Association of Dodgeball therefore has the right to investigate and take disciplinary action against any alleged or suspected breach of this Code of Ethics and Conduct which may bring the game of dodgeball into disrepute.
- 11.2 The following sanctions may be imposed on any individual or club/academy/institution: a warning; a fine; temporary or indefinite suspension from participating or attending any match under the jurisdiction of Malaysia Association of Dodgeball.

# **BY-LAW** VERSION 3 (OCT 1, 2015)

## **IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ANNUAL NATIONAL DODGEBALL DEVELOPMENT STRUCTURE 2015 – 2020**

### **GOVERNING AND PROTECTING THE WELFARE OF THE SPORT WITH GUIDELINES & POLICIES.**

#### **i. PURPOSE OF THE BYLAW**

The purpose of this Bylaw is to provide a clear mandate to regulate all Official Dodgeball Clubs and players registered under the Malaysia Association of Dodgeball.

We believe that Dodgeball Clubs and players can provide opportunities for individuals to develop values and sportsmanship through teamwork and discipline. In addition, skills for personal development namely administrative, organizational and inter personal skills can be gained.

The contents of this Bylaw are designed to ensure that each Club and players operate safely, effectively and efficiently. Therefore, the following policies, procedures and guidelines articulate expectations of adequate supervision and proper management of Clubs and players.

#### **ii. MISSION STATEMENTS**

##### **➤ NATIONAL BODY**

- Making dodgeball a professional sport in the National and International levels.

##### **➤ MARSHALS**

- Ensuring enforcement is conducted with integrity upholding the Honor System.

##### **➤ CLUBS**

- To become an organization that is sustainable & active in participation.

##### **➤ CLUB MANAGERS**

- To ensure the survival, prosperity and participation of clubs in sanctioned competitions.

##### **➤ COACHES**

- To produce and train dodgeball players professionally to compete on all platforms.

##### **➤ PLAYERS**

- To become a professional sports person upholding the values of honesty, integrity and sportsmanship.

### **iii. CORE DEVELOPMENT POLICIES**

- Appointment of Club Managers to liaise and communicate with the assigned Club Development Officers (CDO) by the National Body.
- Manager's responsibility to ensure that the Club and its players abide by the Bylaw, Code of Conduct, Tournament Manuals, Rules and Regulations and other regulatory collaterals that may be added from time to time.
- Players are the Club's responsibility and each competing player shall be registered online and will be reflected on the Club's profile online.
- Clubs and National Body working together to build the sport according to the Club's requirements and development.
- Setting the right principles and values for players to abide to prevent poor sportsmanship and lack of ethical professionalism that may lead to suspension or ban in order to protect the welfare of the sport.
- Programs/Events sanctioning by the National Body to ensure a fair, safe dodgeball event environment throughout Malaysia evidencing the events commitment to abide by the national rules and regulations of the sport.

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# 1.0 TYPES OF RULES & REGULATIONS

## CLUB MANAGERS' RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE CLUB MEMBERS & PLAYERS ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS SET BY THE NATIONAL BODY.

- a) **BYLAW:** Regulations to manage Clubs. Procedures and mandates are set for members and players in accordance to the Annual Dodgeball Development Structure 2015 – 2020.
- b) **CODE OF CONDUCT:** Guidelines for everyone (Officials, Marshals, Coaches, Managers, and Players) to ensure professionalism and sportsmanship is practiced at all times.
- c) **TOURNAMENT MANUALS:** Specific regulations set by the organizers to govern the programs activities such as Tournaments, Leagues (e.g. NDL/ADL) and other competitive activities sanctioned by the National Body.
- d) **RULES & REGULATIONS OF THE SPORT:** Rules and Regulations for the sport itself for all players to comply in tournaments. The rules and regulations will be updated from time to time in line with that of the WDBF (World Dodgeball Federation).

## 1.2 PLAYERS

### CLUB MANAGERS TO BE UPDATED IN UNDERSTANDING THE CURRENT RULES & REGULATIONS AND RELAYING TO THE MEMBERS.

### PLAYERS ARE TO UNDERSTAND CORE THEORY REGULATIONS, GET CLARIFICATIONS & RECEIVE UPDATES VIA MANAGERS.

#### 1.1.1 REGULATION CLARIFICATION

- Managers to use Club Development Officer as point of reference should matter arise for clarification.

#### 1.2.1 CORE THEORY REGULATIONS

- Understanding the foundation and fundamentals of the rules and regulations and applying them professionally.
- Use all fundamentals covered in the rules and regulations in game situations and not deviate based on personal interpretation. Players will be penalized accordingly should they fail to abide by the rules and regulation.

#### 1.1.2 COMMUNICATION PLATFORM

- Medium of interaction between managers & members.
- Social media such as Facebook Fan page as suggested platform for posting information for all members to review.

(a) For example - fundamentals of "live and dead balls" are defined in the rules and regulations of the sport and should be adhered to in each game scenario.

(b) For example - retriever uses retrieved ball in hand to make direct connection with another ball inside the court to ensure that team more can gather both balls within easy reach

#### 1.1.3 MANAGER'S PROGRAM

- Occasional meet up between all Club Managers and MAD officials for latest updates when deemed necessary.

#### 1.1.4 OBTAINING LATEST UPDATES

- Managers and Assistant Managers to receive updates sent through email/SMS follow ups via Club Development Officers.

#### 1.2.2 REGULATION CLARIFICATION

- Managers are the point of reference in regards for clarification to the correct interpretation of certain & its effects.

- 1.2.3 **OBTAINING LATEST UPDATES**
- Players are to check with managers.

#### CLUB CLASSIFICATION

#### PLAYER CLASSIFICATION

##### 2.1.1 **NEW CLUB**

- A club that is newly formed.
- Exists under a period of 1 year from registration
- Any club that re-registers their membership after surpassing expiry & reactivation grace period.
- Can compete on all Non-National Platforms including New/Open Leagues & Tournaments.
- Can upgrade to social/championship club after 1 year.

##### 2.2.1 **NEW PLAYER**

A player registered by a manager under any dodgeball club.  
Less than 1 year dodgeball tournament experience.

##### 2.1.2 **SOCIAL CLUB**

- An upgrade from a New Club upon renewal.
- Exists as a club for more than 1 year.
- Can compete on all Non-National platforms at New / Open Tournaments/Leagues.
- Can upgrade to Championship club if special requirements are met.

##### 2.2.2 **SOCIAL PLAYER**

- A player registered by a manager under a social club.
- 1 year or more dodgeball tournament experience.

##### 2.1.3 **CHAMPIONSHIP CLUB**

- An upgrade by invitation to co-develop the sport.
- A club that competes in the National platform annually.
- A club that can compete on all platforms.

##### 2.2.3 **CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYER**

- A player registered by a manager under a Championship Club.
- Best players selected at the discretion of the club managers to compete in the national championships.

**CHAMPIONSHIP CLUB SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Social / New Club Managers participate in MAD Managers program to update the requirements as a Championship Club Manager.
- Clubs are willing to compete annually in the Championships.
- Clubs & Players fully abide the Bylaw without prejudice.

**CLUB STATUS**

**2.14 ACTIVE CLUB**

- A Club that has registered & paid the annual fees.
- Participates in tournaments.

**2.15 IN-ACTIVE CLUB**

- A Club that fails to renew annual fees after the 1 month grace period given from the expiry date of club membership.

**2.16 SUSPENDED/BANNED CLUB**

- A club that is temporarily banned from competing in any competitions until further notice.

**2.17 TERMINATED CLUB**

- A Club that has surpassed the renewal and grace period.
- The club loses affiliation with MAD till reinstated.

**PLAYER STATUS**

**2.2.4 ACTIVE PLAYER**

- A player that is has registered and signed a contract with a dodgeball club.

**2.2.5 IN-ACTIVE PLAYER**

- A player that fails to renew their contract with the club after their term has expired.

**2.2.6 SUSPENDED/BANNED PLAYER**

- A player that is still registered to a dodgeball club yet is not allowed to participate for a certain period of time due to disciplinary implications.

**2.2.7 TERMINATED PLAYER**

- A player who is removed from a club via the club management committee.

## 3.0 REGISTRATION & AFFILIATION

### 3.1 CLUBS

**CLUBS ARE TO BE REGISTERED & RENEWED WITH THE NATIONAL BODY FOR AFFILIATION & MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES**

#### 3.1.1 CLUB REGISTRATION

- All clubs registered will fall under the category of NEW CLUB.
- A one-off registration fee will imposed.
- Comprises of *Club Certification, Online Club & Player Management System, Logo Creation & Design and regulatory collaterals.*

#### 3.1.2 MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

- Special discounted rates for all programs, activities, equipment and merchandize, a special membership rate will be allocated for all Clubs registered with the National Body.
- Promotion of Club & Club Events through Dodgeball Malaysia Fan page.

#### 3.1.3 CLUB ONLINE PROFILE

- Each Club will have its own Club profile with their players enlisted ONLINE on [www.dodgeball.com.my](http://www.dodgeball.com.my).
- Club online profile will reflect club registration & Expiry Date.

#### 3.1.4 PLAYER & TEAM MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

- System ONLINE will assist the Managers to register players and manage players by sorting them into teams.

#### 3.1.5 ONLINE TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION

- Register ONLINE from list of pre-sorted teams, list will provide picture, name, jersey number, and team name to the tournament organizing committee.

#### 3.1.6 POACHING PLAYERS

- A serious offense of Club poaching a player & may be penalized. Refer to article on Poaching Players & Recruiting Club Players.

### 3.2 PLAYERS

**PLAYERS RECRUITED ARE TO BE REGISTERED & MANAGED BY THE CLUB MANAGER ADHERING TO THE FOLLOWING POLICIES**

#### 3.2.1 PLAYER REGISTRATION

- All individuals are to sign a contract with the club to be entitled as club players.
- All contracts shall last for minimum 1 year (1 season between Jan - Nov). Refer to article on Standardized Club & Player Contract.
- All players need to be registered by managers online as defined in "DEFINITIONS & STATE" .
- A Player that does not appear on the Club profile is not permitted to compete in tournaments under the clubs name.

#### 3.2.2 1 PLAYER 1 CLUB POLICY

- Championship players competing on the national level are to pledge loyalty to the club and can only participate under one (1) championship club only.
- Although not compulsory, all players registered under a dodgeball club are highly encouraged to practice playing for one (1) club to pledge loyalty for any other new/social/open tournaments.

#### 3.2.3 POACHED PLAYERS

- A serious offense to players already signed to a club yet joins another club without consent of their managers.
- Player guilty may be penalized.
- Refer to article on Poaching Players & Recruiting Club Players attachment.

#### 3.2.4 THE HONOR SYSTEM : SPORTSMANSHIP

- The #1 Dodgeball rule for all players to uphold.
- A system based on honesty & integrity.

**3.1.7 CLUB RENEWAL:**

- Clubs that are expiring will be required to conduct a renewal.
- All club renewals is to be completed by **30<sup>th</sup> November annually.**
- The annual fee is made to validate the clubs from the date registered to facilitate the online system and development.
- Upon renewal, clubs that meet the requirements can choose either SOCIAL or CHAMPIONSHIP club.

**3.1.8 GRACE PERIOD:**

- There will be a grace period of 1 month after the club membership has expired. In the event the Club annual fee is not received after the grace the period of 1 month from the date of expiration, the Club will be automatically deregistered by the system.

**3.1.9 CLUB REACTIVATION:**

- To reactivate the Club after deregistration, re-activation fees will be imposed.
- Club registration fees will be prorated accordingly to meet the annual club registration date.

**3.1.10 CLUB TERMINATION:**

- Managers shall notify the Club Development Officer the intention to terminate the club in official writing at least one (1) month prior expiration date of Club's membership.
- The National Body has the right to terminate any Club that *repeatedly fails to follow regulations, continuously demonstrates bad sportsmanship, display any form of negativity, negligence and ignorance detrimental to the sport of Dodgeball* as deemed by the Disciplinary Panel and the Committee members.

**3.2.5 DISCIPLINARY PANEL & SUSPENSION:**

- Players may be penalized by the Disciplinary Board if deemed necessary.

**3.2.6 PLAYER CONTRACT RENEWAL**

- The players' contract can be renewed with the club with consent of club managers.

**3.2.7 PLAYER CONTRACT TERMINATION**

- A player registered can terminate their contract by mutual agreement between the Club & Player during the contractual period.

## 4.0 JERSEY NAME & NUMBER REGULATION

### 4.1 CLUBS

**MANAGERS MUST ENSURE ALL COMPETING PLAYERS HAVE OWN JERSEY NUMBER AND/OR CORRECT NAME PRINTED ON THE JERSEY.**

#### 4.1.1 CLUB PLAYER MASTER LIST

- Managers are recommended to have own spread sheet of all players that includes full name, jersey name, jersey number & contract duration.

#### PLAYER ONLINE SYSTEM REGISTRATION

- The Export Data (TO ADD) option on the online club system exports all players registered.
- The information has to match the Manager's Master list.

#### 4.1.2 PLAYER'S NUMBER

- Club Manager is responsible in assigning the players number.
  - Each player must have own unique number and must match the online player's profile to avoid confusion or conflicting numbers.
- (a) Jersey numbers are assigned only for competing players. Championship players or first team players should have numbers allocated.
- (b) Male and Female players should have different jersey number because of co-ed tournaments.  
\*Suggestions to allocate male players odd numbers and even numbers for female.
- (c) Jersey number can range from 1 to 99. Numbers may be recycled when a player has left the Club (inactive status)
- (d) Jersey number must be 5 inches in height on the front and 10 inches in height on the back. Font can be in Numerals only.
- (e) For players wearing head scarves which may block the number on the jersey, the number has to be visible. (Below the head scarf seam or anywhere visible front and back)

### 4.2 PLAYERS

**MANAGERS WILL ENSURE PLAYER'S JERSEY NUMBER AND NAME PRINTED ACCORDING TO THE ONLINE SYSTEM TO IDENTIFY ILLEGAL AND BAD SPORTSMANSHIP PLAYERS.**

#### 4.2.1 JERSEY REGULATION VIOLATION

Some examples of jersey violation that would not allow players to compete

- (a) Uniforms that do not match,
- (b) Players sharing same jersey/number,
- (c) No jersey numbers (in front or back or both)
- (d) Using nicknames or abbreviation.
- (e) Details not matching with registration.

#### 4.2.2 ILLEGAL PLAYERS

- Players not registered by the Club and is not on the registration list but is on the team's line up at tournament.
- Illegal player rules apply, see **Sport Rules & Regulations**.

#### 4.2.3 SPORTS ATTIRE

- Players are expected to dress appropriately to play for the sport.
- Players are not allowed to compete without proper sport shoes.
